Juilliard JAZZ SUMMER WORKSHOPS



The Juilliard Summer Jazz Residency (June 14 – 18, 2010) is a one-week program for students, ages 12 to 18, who are dedicated, disciplined, and passionate about jazz. Located at Sutton Middle School, the program is designed to give young jazz musicians a taste of what a Juilliard Jazz student's life is all about: refining technique, performance, and broadening understanding of various jazz styles. Teachers include members of the Juilliard Jazz Division faculty, as well as Juilliard students.

Instruments for the Juilliard Summer Jazz Residency in Atlanta:
Trumpet, Saxophone, Trombone, Guitar, Piano, Double Bass, Electric Bass, and Drums.

Please note:

- Guitar, Double Bass, and Electric Bass students are required to bring their own amp and pick-up cables to all rehearsals and performances.
- There is no vocal program.

Program Schedule

The day begins with musicianship class followed by Individual practice and Small Ensemble/Combo work. After lunch, students have additional ensemble rehearsals, listening sessions, Big Band rehearsal and each day ends with a Jam session. In addition to the daily classes and rehearsals, the repertoire studies during the week will be performed on the final day of the residency. Program structure may be adjusted according to enrollment.

Students would be in session from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm with daily required practice sessions.

Juilliard Summer Jazz Residency in Atlanta music requirements:

The camp will begin with placement into ensembles. Students should be prepared to:

- Play *C Jam Blues* by Duke Ellington
- Advanced students may choose a jazz standard from the list below:
 - *Blue Bossa*
 - *Autumn Leaves*
 - *Stella by Starlight*
 - *Now's The Time*
- Students may be asked to play 1 major and/or 1 minor scale (2 octaves)

Location

All classes and concerts for the Juilliard Summer Jazz Residency will take place at Sutton Middle School, 4360 Powers Ferry Road NW, Atlanta, GA 30327. Students and parents are expected to make their own transportation arrangements; no bus service will be provided. Students are expected to bring lunch and snacks daily. Program structure may be adjusted according to enrollment. No housing is provided.
